

## SIXTEENTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME 19 JULY 2020

### Gathered around the altar once again

This weekend was filled with great thanksgiving as we celebrated public Holy Masses for the first time in four months. I know it has been a tremendous consolation to so many to be able to approach the altar once again for the nourishment of Holy Communion. Please God these first tentative steps will increase our confidence to come back to Mass if we are able. We look forward to welcoming you back to weekly Mass.

It is important to note that the Bishops of Scotland continue to dispense all Catholics from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass for the foreseeable future. This means that no-one is obligated to attend Holy Mass at this time. Those who are shielding or advised to remain at home should not attend Mass. This also includes those displaying COVID symptoms or those in quarantine/self-isolation. Of course, I encourage those who are able to come back to Church and to re-establish the routine of weekly Mass attendance.

As you know, those who can attend Mass will be required to register with the parish in advance. It is not possible to attend without this prior registration. Everyone must wear a face-covering in the Church (except children under 5 or those who have a relevant medical condition). Attendance at each Mass is capped at 50 persons. Funerals, marriages and baptisms are capped at 20 people. I understand that these are extremely low numbers given the size of our church building, but this limit has not been set by the parish. We ask everyone to be patient as we do our best to accommodate all the requests. However, in some cases it may mean attending a weekday 10am Mass rather than your regular Sunday Mass.

If you would like to attend a Sunday Mass or weekday Mass then simply call the parish on **01236 427538** from 12pm - 3pm every day. Please give your name, address & phone contact. This information is required to assist with the *Track & Trace* system. Please share this booking telephone number with family, friends and neighbours who cannot access it via this online bulletin.

For those who remain at home I will continue to broadcast all our Masses and services, including the 10am daily Mass. I want you to remain connected to the parish, even from home. Be assured that I bring your intentions to the altar each day. God bless, Fr. Kane
