Covid-19 Update – Easing of Restrictions

In recent times, public health guidance has relaxed some of the rules for visits to public places. In turn, this has an impact on those attending places of worship like St. Augustine's. The only remaining restrictions are listed below.

Hand Sanitising

This is still a requirement as you enter the Church. Please also consider using your own personal hand sanitiser before you leave your pew for Holy Communion.

Face Coverings UPDATE

The wearing of face covering is no longer mandatory in Places of Worship.

It is now up to personal choice and discretion if you wish to wear a mask in church.

Ventilation

The church doors will remain open to allow for the free circulation of air throughout the building.

I would like to convey my heartfelt thanks to our amazing team of stewards who looked after us all so well during the restrictions. They have shown tremendous faithfulness to this important work. The idea of forming a more long-term *welcoming ministry* is one I welcome wholeheartedly. This is something I hope to formalise as a new ministry in our parish in the near future!

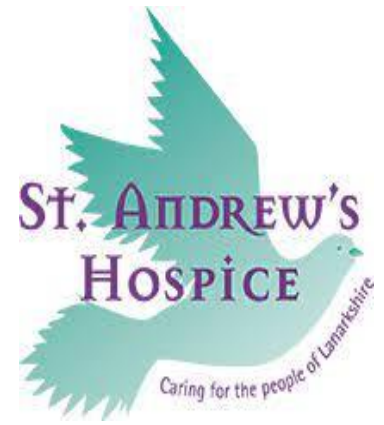

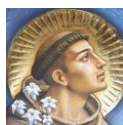

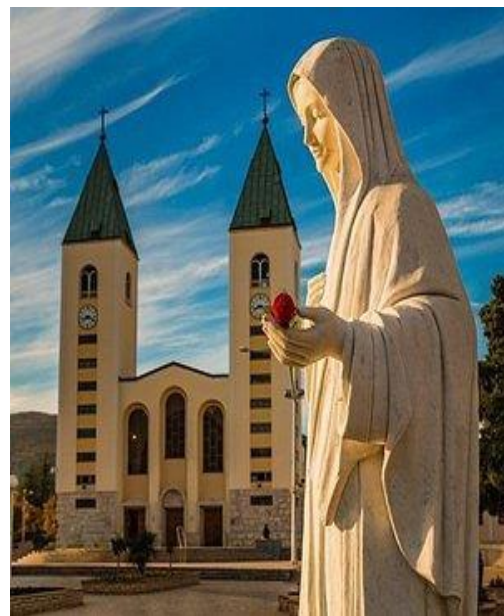

ALTAR SERVERS & YOUNG READERS' RETREAT

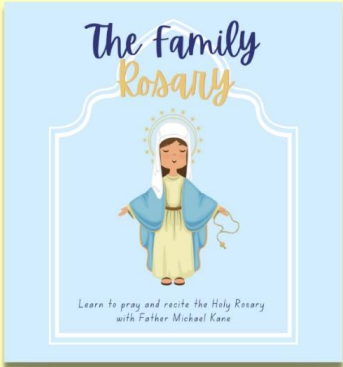

The People's Pantry

Helping Local People with Free Food Support

Please remember that our parish People's Pantry Foobank is open **every Thursday from 12pm – 3pm** at Blairgrove Shopping Centre on Bank Street.

Given the increased numbers we are seeing each week, we will open an additional evening to support families and individuals unable to make it through the working day. A huge thanks to our team of dedicated volunteers who have made this possible.

The new opening hours are now:

Mondays from 6pm – 8pm

Thursdays 12pm – 3pm

No referral is required. Simply show-up and we will give you a free 3-day bag of food for you and your household. No questions asked!

We have also recently linked with the local Citizens Advice Bureau who offer advocacy services via our Pantry.

HOW YOU CAN HELP

Can you support our parish foodbank with vital food donations? At present, we are running low on the following essential non-perishable items:

Tins of soup / beans / pasta / rice tinned meat pies / cereals / tea bags / coffee / pasta sauce / sugar biscuits / crisps

Food donations can be left at the sacristy after any Mass or at the Parish House through the day.



CLOTHING SUPPORT

The parish recently took delivery of a very large quantity of new clothing and footwear which was kindly donated by The Knights of Malta based in London.

We will be looking to give these items away freely to anyone in our community who is in need.

Sacrament of the Sick / Hospital Visitations

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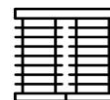
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
