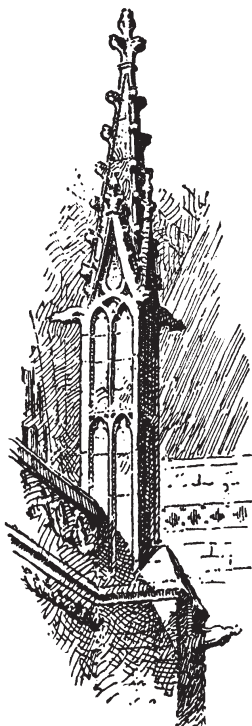

DIACONATE ORDINATION
