DIACONATE ORDINATION

It is with great joy to share with you that Christopher Furmage, a seminarian of our Parish, was ordained to the Diaconate on Saturday, 13th April in Rome.

Chris, who has been studying at the Pontifical Scots College in Rome for the past 6 years, was ordained a Deacon by Bishop Toal in St Paul's Basilica in Rome.

Ordination to the Diaconate is one of the final major steps for a seminarian before ordination to the Priesthood. Chris will spend his final year of formation serving as a Deacon before, God willing, being ordained a Priest for the Diocese next summer.

Many of you will know Chris as a Parishioner of our Parish. I ask you to pray for him as he takes this next step in his journey towards Priesthood.
